All CTI staff escaped injury from falling materials and equipment. The guys at our diecasting plant valiantly fought to contain fires from molten aluminium for several hours, using up in the process, over 22 fire extinguishers.

Neither the Disraeli Street nor Tanya Street sites have suffered major structural damage and all staff, to their credit, despite personal circumstances, have returned to work as of Monday 28 February and we were able to commence most production immediately.

Deliveries have been affected, and priority is being given to those customers directly contributing to the Christchurch recovery.

CTI will be contacting all our customers and suppliers in the near future to ensure that we are able to meet your needs.

We trust you will show understanding during this difficult time while we go through the recovery process.

We are concerned for the safety and welfare of our staff and are working with them to assist in their recovery.
